“The Walker County Department of Human Resources has a need for foster and adoptive parents.

There are more than 60 children in foster care in this county and fewer than 30 licensed foster homes.

Foster parents provide temporary care, love and support for children who are experiencing family crises due to abuse and neglect. A safe, caring home environment can give these children the stability they need to cope with feelings of abandonment, anger and loss.

I thought it good to put this in the bulletin on Mother’s Day because it may be that some would like to have a child in their home again or add another child for a time to their home. These children are in great need and it would provide a good Christian home for these children for a period of time.

Children are a blessing from God. Some are terribly mistreated and need a safe, loving home environment in which to heal their emotional, and possibly physical, wounds. What better place to do that than in the home composed of a Christian mother and father. I am sure that the Walker County Department of Human Resources would greatly appreciate your help in this endeavor and it could be a good evangelistic tool for the Lord..
