**THINGS MOST PRECIOUS (Pt. 1)**

**I. The \_\_\_\_\_ of your faith (1 Peter 1:7).**

- A. Trials are precious, because when passed through successfully, they lead to the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus at His return.
- B. Notice the last phrase of the verse.
  - 1. Trials \_\_\_\_\_ us (James 1:2-3).
  - 2. We will have Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ if we make it through our trials.
- C. A key \_\_\_\_\_ we need to grasp is the that we will have trials in this life.
  - 1. 1 Thessalonians 3:3-4.
  - 2. 2 Timothy 3:12.
- D. Suffering now strengthens us for the trials that lay \_\_\_\_\_.
- E. We are not above our \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 10:24).
  - 1. Jesus suffered greatly and left us His \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Peter 2:21).
