WHAT'S GOING ON TODAY?

To our visitors, please know that you are our honored guests. We thank you for coming and being a part of this special day. Someone took the time to invite you and you have taken the time to accept the offered invitation. We do not take that lightly and we are humbled by your presence with us today. If you have never attended a worship service here, there may be some things you wonder about as we worship God today. Hopefully, what you are reading will guide you through our worship service and you won't feel out of place.

We will begin with announcements. This is not part of the worship service, but it lets us know the sick and the bereaved so that we can pray for them during our service. Also, it will let those who are going to be leading in the various parts of the worship service know their responsibilities.

We will begin our worship with songs of praise to God. God has asked those that worship Him to sing to one another in order to edify one another and also to bring glory and praise to His name (Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16). We will have a song leader who leads us in these songs and everyone has the privilege of raising their voices to God together.

After two songs, we will have a scripture reading which goes along with the sermon that will be delivered. After the reading, one of the men of the congregation will lead us in a prayer (1 Timothy 2:8).

We will have one more song, after which, the song leader will ask us to mark a particular song that will be sung at the close of the sermon. The preacher will then get up and lead us in a study of God's word through the means of a sermon. Preaching is the means by which God wants His message to be gotten to man and to strengthen His people (1 Corinthians 1:18-25). At the close of the sermon, the Lord's invitation will be extended and those who have been pricked in their hearts by the word of God can respond to that invitation by coming forward and being aided by the preacher.

We will then have the opportunity to give back to God as He has prospered us. This offering is for the members here and our visitors do not need to feel obligated to give unless they so desire. After that, we will sing one more song and then partake of the Lord's Supper, something we do every first day of the week (Acts 20:7). This Supper is for Christians and, when it is passed to you, if you so desire you may partake of it. After this, we will have closing announcements and a dismissal prayer.
